



Composting toilets less draining

During National Water Week, Ecoflo Water Management is challenging Victorians to make the switch to waterless toilets where they can to prevent thousands of litres of drinking water being flushed down the drain.

Ecoflo Managing Director Stuart Elliott said his 'zero water input' products mirror the 'Water for Life' theme of National Water Week because they help homeowners make a big contribution

to the conservation of Australia's shrinking water supplies.

"With no foreseeable change to the current drought conditions, Australians are embracing water saving technology more than ever," Mr Elliott said. "Waterless toilets are as efficient as flushing toilets, are cheaper to maintain, don't smell and, more importantly, they don't use one drop of water.

"Simply by installing a waterless toilet house-

holds could save 35,000 litres of water each year!"

Commenting on the emergence of water saving products in the marketplace Mr Elliott said manufacturers were realising a responsibility to make water saving products to help households minimise water consumption.

"Since starting Ecoflo 15 years ago there has been a significant rise in demand from consumers for our prod-

ucts," Mr Elliott said.

"Reusing greywater has become a popular water-saving strategy among consumers and we recently started making and supplying greywater systems.

"Our greywater systems collect and treat the water used in bathrooms, kitchens and laundry, so it can be safely reused in the garden to water lawns and plants."

Mr Elliott said the only aspect individuals needed to consider was

their local council's regulations for treating grey water or waste water.

"Some councils impose regulations on the installation of waterless toilets and Greywater systems. At Ecoflo we have a wealth of experience assisting homeowners with obtaining council approval and are happy to assist with the application process," Mr
